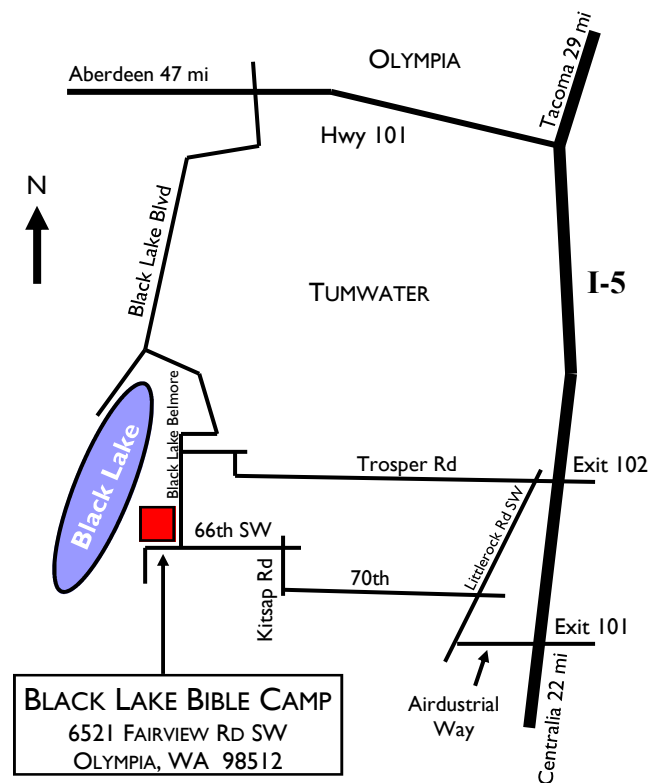
Brandon Pangman has been married to Jenny for 25 years and they have three children (Mya, Ian and Eli.)
