


Rev. Adam Jensen

EVERYDAY MISSIONARIES

Each one of us is called by God into various vocations. If we think of our vocations as just jobs and not a calling, we can miss out on God's missional opportunities. God gives us many ordinary responsibilities in everyday life. My prayer is that we would view ordinary, everyday jobs as an opportunity to serve as God's missionary people. This weekend, we will explore ways to bring Jesus with us into our workplaces, families, and neighborhoods.

SESSION 1 THE MESSAGE

What is the good news of Jesus Christ? When presented with an opportunity to share, are you able to articulate the gospel? By examining passages from the Gospels, we will learn the good news of Jesus as well as a gospel outline that can be easily shared. We will also consider possible responses people will have as they hear the message of Jesus Christ.

SESSION 2 THE MISSION FIELDS

Did you know that God has placed you where you are today for a reason? You are called by God to various responsibilities in life. Those areas of responsibility present opportunities to build friendships and to be a witness. This session aims to help you identify your mission field and those who live in it. God is calling each of us to serve our neighbors through our vocations as we serve as Christ's ambassadors.

SESSION 3 THE METHODS

There isn't one method that fits all situations. It is important to know how to share the good news of Jesus through a testimony, a simple Gospel outline, or an invitation. I will share a couple of easy methods for sharing the Gospel with others. We will also learn that our ears are just as important a tool as our mouths. Moreover, our heart's motivation must be right.
